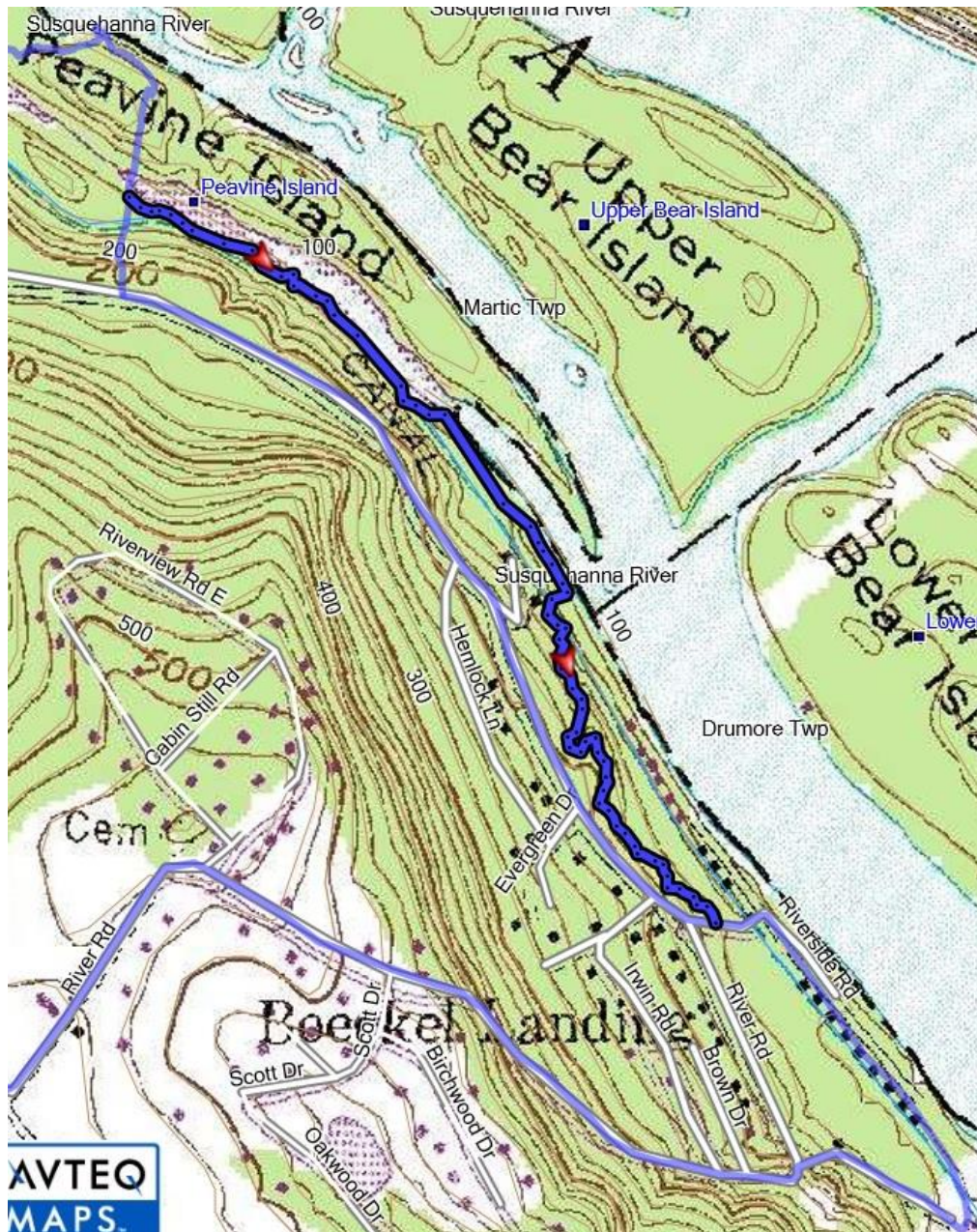


Lock 15 to Peavine Island Reroute



WEST TO EAST

- 10.0 mi Turn left toward the river, go under Norman Wood Bridge (Rt. 372), pass Lock 13, and continue onto Peavine Island which should be explored for its beauty. Leave the island, turn down river.
- 10.8 mi Turn left before hill, trail winds through scattered rocks.
- 10.9 mi Climb rungs up large rock face, continue through rocks
- 11.1 mi Continue ahead on tow path, after cabin turn right.
- 11.3 mi Turn left on driveway, then straight ahead into woods.
- 11.6 mi Turn left on road descending to PECO's Lock 15 Interpretive Park. Follow path by canal and reconstructed lock. (Picnic tables)

Continue on Map 5 at 11.8 mi

EAST TO WEST

- 18.6 mi Turn left, upriver, and follow path to canal, restored lock in Exelon's Lock 15 Interpretive Park.
- 18.8 mi Continue on road leading left back up to River Road. After 250', turn right into woods
- 19.1 mi Continue down driveway, in 50' turn right and descend to river, turn left and follow tow path upriver.
- 19.3 mi Continue ahead over and around many large rocks.
- 19.5 mi Descend rock face on rungs, continue through rocks.
- 19.6 mi Turn right, then left, follow trail onto Peavine Island. *The island is beautiful and merits extra exploration.* The trail returns to shore, passes Lock 13, a foundation of an old covered bridge, and goes under the Norman Wood Bridge (Rt.372). (During high water, stay on River Road and follow it to Rt.372; cross Rt.372 and turn right into the first parking area and pick up the trail again at the bottom of the lower parking lot).

Continue on Map 5 at 20.3 mi.
