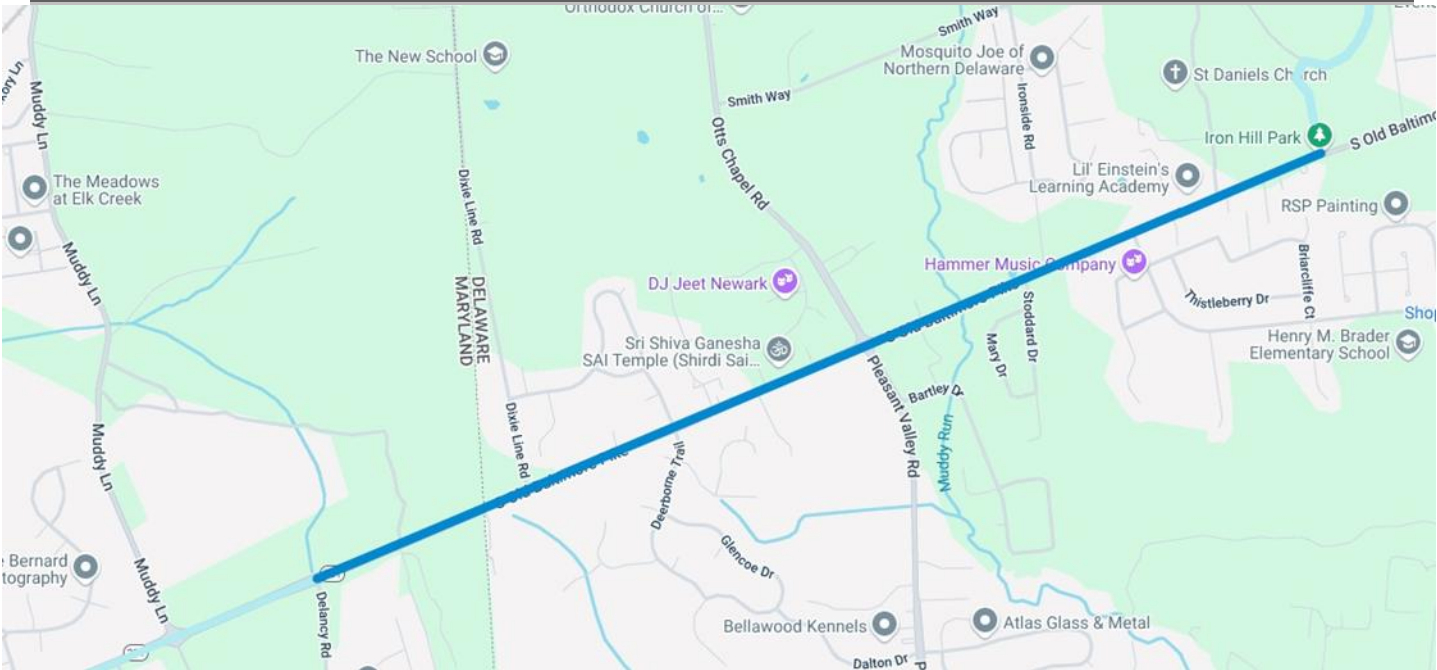


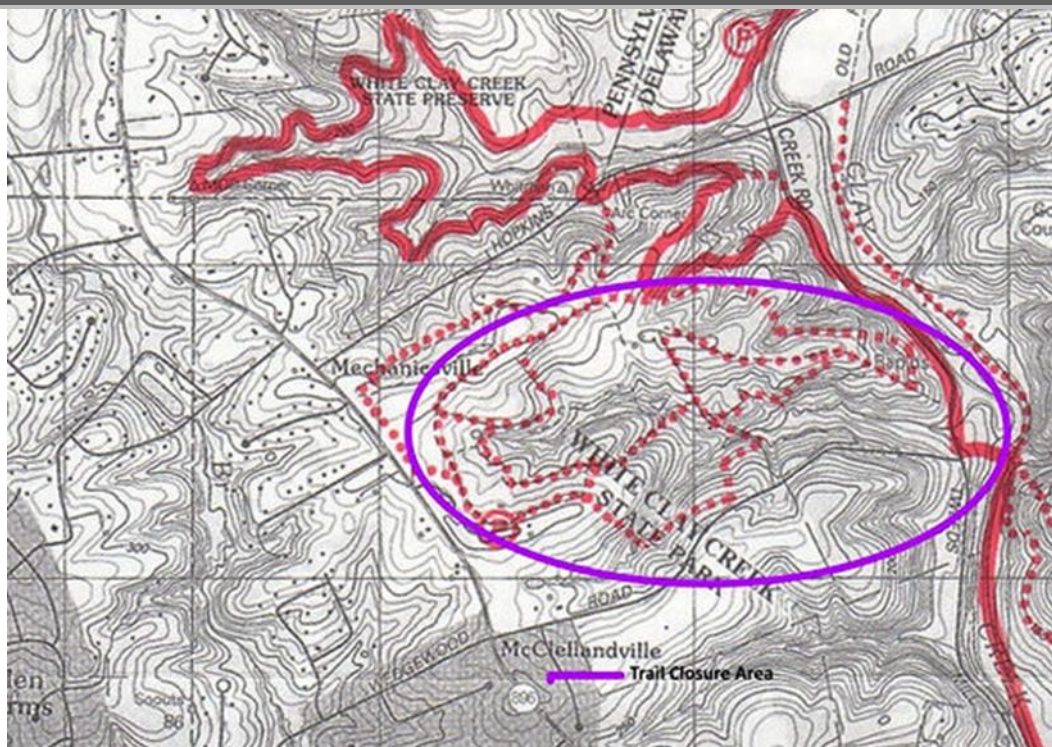
Map 9: Delancy Road, MD to White Clay Creek Park at London Tract Road, DE.

Location	Comments
Red Hill Rd at Delancy Rd, MD to Iron Hill Park, DE	The road walk along Old Baltimore Pike/Red Hill Rd to Delancy Rd is mostly on shoulders but there are occasionally turn lanes that eliminate the shoulder. In that case either walk in the grass on the side of the road or wait until there's no traffic in or approaching the turn lane before proceeding.

<p>0.0 mi From here to Iron Hill Park there are several turn lanes that eliminate the shoulder. When you encounter one, walk on the extreme left of the pavement and step onto the grass for oncoming traffic. Before the traffic light, wait by the guardrail until the lane is clear, then carefully proceed, next to the guardrail and facing traffic. Continue in the grass until the shoulder returns. Follow blazes on utility poles.</p> <p>0.3 mi Cross into Delaware. Continue on Old Baltimore Pike.</p> <p>1.1 mi When the shoulder narrows, step on the grass for oncoming vehicles. At the traffic signal, carefully cross Otts Chapel Rd and continue on the grass until the end of the turn lanes. Continue on the shoulder.</p> <p>2.1 mi Turn left up gravel driveway of Iron Hill Museum. Enter woods to the left through arch sign "Iron Mine Trail," with small museum building on the right. The trail passes some old iron mine pits.</p> <p>Subtract 0.5 mi from remaining mileages</p>	<p>20.2mi Emerge from woods into clearing of Iron Hill Museum on left. Proceed down drive on right and carefully cross Old Baltimore Pike. Turn right and continue on the shoulder. Follow blazes on utility poles. From here to Delancy Rd, there are several turn lanes that eliminate the shoulder. When you encounter one, walk on the extreme left of the pavement and step onto the grass for oncoming traffic.</p> <p>21.1 mi At the traffic signal, carefully cross Pleasant Valley Rd, then continue on the grass until the end of the turn lane. Continue on the shoulder facing traffic.</p> <p>21.9 mi Cross into Maryland on Red Hill Rd, MD-281.</p> <p>22.3 mi Arrive at Delancy Rd</p>

16.5	Leave Susquehanna State Park, continue on Lapidum Rd	0.6	From Quarry Rd turn right onto Graceview Dr
18	Turn left into parking lot, just past Rt-95 bridge	0.7	Turn right onto Bern Dr
18.1	Follow trail through Vulcan Quarry area. This is private property, stay on trail	0.9	Turn Right onto Arthur Dr
19.1	Enter field and turn left onto Rt-155	1.0	Bear left onto Nena Ave follow to dead end
19.4	Turn left to enter Ambulance Corps grounds follow the outside perimeter to Nena Ave	1.3	Enter Ambulance Corps grounds bearing to the right then follow the outside perimeter to Rt-155
19.6	Follow Nena Ave to Arthur Dr	1.5	Turn right onto Rt-155 (Level Rd)
19.9	Bear right onto Arthur Dr	1.8	Turn right where field ends, follow trail through Vulcan Quarry area. This is private property, stay on trail
20	Turn left onto Bern Dr	2.9	Enter parking lot, turn right onto Lapidum Rd
20.2	Turn left onto Graceview Dr	4.4	Enter Susquehanna State Park, continue on Lapidum Rd
